
Welcome to this tutorial on how to put KIDS4ALLL inclusive key strategies into practice.

Here are some reflections for your inspiration:



Sharing the knowledge!

On the KIDS4ALLL platform, young people are asked to share their knowledge with their buddies and to widen it through peer- and inquiry-based learning. This process helps the buddy-teams to get access to various resources, using their language skills and contacts to get different insights on a certain topic.



Local communities

The projects also provide families with the chance to get involved, sharing their valued knowledge. The buddy-teams' field research can also strengthen the relationship with local communities.





Collaboration

Instead of competition, there is supported collaboration: The buddies accomplish tasks together, like doing research and sharing the results. Following the jigsaw-method, you can initiate knowledge-sharing processes not only within the buddy-team but also between teams. The young people will develop their ability to sort, select, organise and present content to others. They will also experience learning as something lively and exciting, and by taking on the role of the experts themselves, their self-confidence will grow!



What needs to be valued!

Very important: PERFECTION is not expected! ENGAGEMENT is what needs to be valued. For example: A buddy team consists of both a native and a non-native speaker. Should the native-buddy speak for both in the presentation? No! KIDS4ALLL is about engaging and growing with the tasks and its challenges.
