Support buddy teams to create engaging presentations!

Welcome! In this tutorial you will get some ideas on how to support buddy teams to create engaging presentations.

1. Provide guidance!

Provide guidance by making sure your youngsters understand what they have to do and what tools are needed to succeed. Learning new skills can be exciting, but also daunting for them. Be there when they need you.



2. Encourage them!



Always encourage them to believe in themselves. Remind them to start with a simple idea. Practice makes perfect! Help them plan their presentation step-by-step, perhaps assigning each other team roles, so they won't get overwhelmed by the tasks. Regular check-ins will help them maintain deadlines and prevent them from going in the wrong direction. Keep in mind that cut-out and whiteboard animations may take longer though.

3. Get familiar as well!

Creating videos is optional and not everyone's cup of tea. Don't forget that infographics and whiteboard animations can be done without video. And cut-out animations can become little theatre pieces, using magnets to move the characters from behind a fixed background.





In case they want to create a video, there are plenty of websites to learn simple editing techniques. Your youngsters might already know them from using social media, so you better get familiar as well! Research tools, techniques, and practical examples of each of the methods they might want to use.
